Declaratory Statement for cases where the land is no subject to
private entry

J. P. G. Benson of Calabasas Ariz. being a male citizen of the United States and one twenty one years of age have on the twenty second day of March A.D. 1885 settled and improved the West $\frac{1}{2}$ of the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of S 19 Township 21 S of range 13 E, ^{in Pima County Ariz.} in the district of lands subject to sale at the land office at Tucson and containing 80 (Eighty) acres which land has not yet been offered at Public Sale thus rendered subject to private entry; and I do hereby declare my intention to claim the said tract of land a presumption right under the provisions of said act 4th September 1841.
